Home Heating Credit Assistance



If you're a Michigan **HOMEOWNER or RENTER** you might qualify for help with some of your heating bills through the Michigan Home Heating Credit (HHC).

You may qualify for the HHC if:

- You are a Michigan homeowner or renter
- Your household meets the income guidelines
- You have your heat bill or your heat is included in your rent.

**These guidelines are meant to provide general eligibility rules, however, the actual credit amount and your qualification may differ or be affected by other factors or special situations. If you have questions about your eligibility, call Accounting Aid Society at the number below.*

HOW DO I APPLY?

Accounting Aid Society has 4 tax sites open for continued tax assistance and can help you apply for the HHC by filling out the required form (we'll provide the form!), which must be completed and filed by **September 30, 2022**. See if you qualify, make an appointment, bring your documents and– we'll do the rest.

Even though you do not need to file a tax return or have tax filing requirements to apply for the HHC, we'll double-check your information to see if you're eligible for other tax benefits while we're at it!
